
The court grants Ms. Holland's motion for a terminating sanction in part pursuant to CCP 128(a)(4). The evidence demonstrates that Mr. Connelly has continued to violate the court's preliminary injunction and contempt orders. Mr. Connelly has not provided sufficient access to Ms. Holland for the VegNews' accounts. (Holland dec., pars. 38, 46, and 58). Ms. Holland also introduces additional evidence of Mr. Connelly's bad faith conduct, including engaging in an illegal surveillance scheme. (Holland dec., pars. 32-35; Penal Code sec. 637.7). The court strikes the declaration of Mr. Connelly because it does not comply with CCP 2015.5

1 and is not under penalty of perjury. The court issues an evidentiary sanction and rules that Ms.
2 Holland is half (50%) owner of VegNews and that finding is established for all purposes.
