After considering the papers, the Court issued a tentative ruling on June 12, 2014 which was not contested by the parties. Accordingly, The Court now adopts its tentative ruling and hereby orders, adjudges, and decrees as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the motion is GRANTED. Ms. Holland demonstrates that she is a co-owner of the business known as VegNews and Mr. Connelly has been misusing his position to her detriment. A receiver is necessary to protect her property rights. See Code of Civil Procedure section 564(b)(9); Neider v. Dardi (1955) 130 Cal.App.2d 646, 649. Further the Preliminary Injunction, issued by the Court on March 25, 2013, has failed to protect Ms. Holland's ownership Accordingly, the Court appoints Susan Uecker of Uecker & Associates, Inc. as a Receiver interest. with broad powers to manage VegNews and restrain Mr. Connelly from taking advantage of his position as a co-owner.

Consistent with the provisions of California Rules of Court sections 3179 through 3184, the Receiver shall perform his or her duties through time of appointment through the entrance of Judgment in this case, unless otherwise removed through Order of this Court or agreement of the parties. The Receiver and the parties to this case may, at any time, apply to this Court for further or other instructions or orders and for further powers necessary to enable the Receiver to perform the Receiver's duties properly. The Receiver's bond is waived.

The Receiver shall prepare monthly statements reflecting the Receiver's fees and administrative costs and expenses incurred for the period of the Receiver's administration of the receivership estate. Upon service of each statement via mail or electronic mail, the Receiver may disburse from estate funds the amount of each statement. Notwithstanding the period payment of fees and expenses, all fees and expenses shall be submitted to the Court for its final approval and confirmation, in the form of either a stipulation of all parties or in the Receiver's Final Account and Report.

The Receiver's fees and expenses, subject to the approval of the above entitled Court, shall
